Partnering w/Church Plants

Carmel Serve week is a great opportunity to partner with local church plants as they seek to share the gospel right here in Charlotte.

One of our key partnerships is with Life Church. Life Church, along with the previous members of Southside Baptist Church, was launched on September 9, 2018 as a brand new church in the South End borough of Charlotte.
